Why is the City implementing a storm water fee?

- To provide funding to manage storm water drainage problems in the City
- To provide funding to implement a storm water program for the City
- To ensure illicit storm water discharge from the City does not impact the public waterways

How will the storm water fee be used?

- To minimize and eliminate storm water drainage problems in the City
- To design and construct storm water infrastructure within the City
- To develop, maintain and operate a storm water program for the City

How much is the storm water fee and when will it be implemented?

The storm water fee will be implemented on the October 2016 water and sewer bill, and will be as follows:

- For Residential Customers\$4/month
- For Commercial Customers\$5/month
- For Major Industry/Retail, base on the following SF of impervious surfaces:
 - 10,000 – 100,000 SF = \$10.00/Month
 - 100,001 – 200,000 SF = 20.00/Month
 - 200,001 – 300,000 SF = \$30.00/Month
 - 300,001 – 400,000 SF = \$40.00/Month
 - 400,001 – 500,000 SF = \$50.00/Month

For Residential Customers, your basic water and sewer bill will be \$39.50 for September 2016. Therefore, beginning October 2016 your basic water and sewer bill, to include the storm water fee, will be \$43.50. The October 2016 basic water and sewer bill will increase for Commercial and Major Industry/Retail customers as noted above.
